

ORDINANCE NO. O-C-12-2

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANIMAL WELFARE, CONTROL AND
EDUCATION ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana, on December 28, 2011 passed Ordinance No. O-C-11-7 entitled the Animal Welfare, Control and Education Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana desires to amend the Ordinance to remove Section 2 regarding Licenses and Permits until such time as the Perry County Council chooses to enact a dog tax in Perry County.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana as follows:

1. Section 2: Licenses and Permits of Ordinance No. O-C-11-7 is hereby deleted in its entirety, is of no further force and effect, and shall be replaced with the following: SECTION 2: RESERVED.
2. The first sentence of SECTION 4(j) shall be amended to state in its entirety as follows: "The Board shall approve or disapprove all applications for permits and licenses, if such are required, for animals based on the Board's determination as to whether the applicant has complied with this Ordinance and demonstrates a reasonable probability of continued compliance." The remaining portions of SECTION 4(j) shall remain in full force and effect.
3. The remaining sections of Ordinance No. O-C-11-7 shall remain in full force and effect.
4. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and signing.
