

PUBLIC LEGAL NOTICE & INVITATION TO BID
ASPHALT MILLING PLACEMENT PROJECT
CANADA ROAD WITH OPTIONAL COTTONWOOD ROAD PLACEMENT

Perry County Board of Commissioners, Indiana

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana, will receive sealed bids for the loading, hauling, asphalt emulsion application, placement, and compaction of County-owned asphalt millings on Canada Road in Perry County, Indiana, with optional additional placement on Cottonwood Road if milling material remains after Canada Road is completed.

1. Submission Instructions & Deadlines

Sealed bid proposals must be received no later than 2pm local time on Thursday September 3rd 2026. The Board of Commissioners will hold a special public meeting on Friday, September 4th 2026 at 2:00pm in the Perry County Courthouse 2219 Payne Street Tell City, IN 47586. Bids will be published in the Perry County News on Thursday August 20th and the second publication will be Thursday August 27th, 2026.

Advance Delivery Address: Bids may be delivered in advance to the Perry County Auditor's Office, 2219 Payne St., Tell City, IN 47586, provided they are received before the stated deadline.

Bid Identification: Each sealed bid shall be clearly marked "Canada Road Asphalt Milling Placement Project — Do Not Open."

Late Submissions: Any bid received after the stated deadline will be rejected and returned unopened.

Bid Opening: Properly submitted bids will be opened publicly and read aloud at the special public meeting of the Board of Commissioners.

Bid Pricing: Each bid shall include a total price for completion of the Canada Road work and a separate optional unit price per linear foot for the Cottonwood Road work described below.

2. Detailed Scope of Work

The successful bidder shall provide all management, labor, machinery, tools, fuel, and transportation required to perform the following work:

Project Limits: Canada Road begins at State Road 145 and extends approximately 2.7 miles to Cascade Road. The finished roadway width shall be 18 feet.

Estimated Material Quantity: The County estimates approximately 1,750 tons of asphalt millings per mile for an 18-foot-wide roadway, or approximately 4,725 tons for

Canada Road. This quantity is an estimate only. The millings were purchased by the truckload, and the tonnage of individual loads may vary.

Load & Transport: Load County-owned asphalt millings from the stockpile at Seifrig Trucking LLC, 6723 State Road 62, Birdseye, IN 47513 and transport them to Canada Road. The stockpiled millings were obtained from Interstate 64.

Tack Coat Application: Prepare and treat the existing gravel base of Canada Road with SS-1h or CSS-1h asphalt emulsion tack coat applied undiluted at a rate of 0.10 to 0.15 gallons per square yard.

Paving Operations: Place the asphalt millings using a mechanical self-propelled asphalt paver.

Compaction Target: Compact the placed millings to a clean, uniform finished compacted thickness of 3 inches.

Density & Moisture Control: Introduce moisture as necessary during mechanical rolling to achieve a minimum dry density of 95 percent of the applicable maximum dry density, as determined by a testing method approved by the County.

County Responsibility: Perry County highway crews will grade and prepare the existing roadway base before the contractor's scheduled mobilization.

Optional Cottonwood Road Work: Canada Road shall be completed first. If asphalt milling material remains after completion of Canada Road, the County may direct the contractor to place the remaining material on Cottonwood Road. The Cottonwood Road placement shall be 18 feet wide and shall follow the same specifications stated above. The bidder shall provide a separate optional price per linear foot. Payment will be based on the actual number of full-width linear feet completed and accepted. Work shall begin at a location designated by the County and continue until the available milling material is exhausted or the County directs the contractor to stop. The County does not guarantee any minimum quantity of Cottonwood Road work.

3. Critical Project Window

Work Window: Paving operations shall begin no earlier than September 15, 2026 and shall be fully completed no later than October 1, 2026. The work shall be scheduled and performed during suitable warm-weather conditions.

4. Legal Provisions & Administrative Terms

Workers' Compensation Insurance: The successful bidder shall secure and maintain Workers' Compensation insurance as required by Indiana law. The contractor shall provide a verified Certificate of Insurance establishing Employer's Liability limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident before mobilization.

Commercial General Liability Insurance: The successful bidder shall maintain Commercial General Liability insurance with limits of not less than \$1,000,000 per

occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate and shall provide a verified Certificate of Insurance before mobilization.

Indemnification & Hold Harmless: To the fullest extent permitted by law, the contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Perry County, Indiana, and its elected officials, officers, employees, and agents from claims, bodily injuries, property damage, losses, and reasonable legal defense costs to the extent caused by the acts, errors, omissions, or operations of the contractor or its subcontractors.

Change Orders & Payments: No change in the scope, price, or time for the work shall be valid unless approved in a written change order by the County. Payments shall be made in accordance with the County's standard LIT road bid payment provisions, which shall be included in the contract documents, and only for work completed and accepted by the County.

Reservation of Rights & Rejection of Bids: The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive nonmaterial irregularities or informalities to the extent permitted by law. If an award is made, the contract shall be awarded to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. The County may award the Canada Road work alone or may also exercise the optional Cottonwood Road work.
