PERRY COUNTY COUNCIL MINUTES OCTOBER 14, 2021

The Perry County Council met on the above date at 5:00 p.m. as was duly advertised for the adoption of the 2022 budgets. Council members in attendance were: David A Etienne, Danny Bolin, Earla Williams and Lynn Fulkerson. Luke Thomas, Charles Baumeister and Paul Malone were not in attendance. S. Rod Acchiardo, Council Attorney, also was not in attendance. Chief Deputy Eric Dickenson was in attendance.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

2022 BUDGET ADOPTION

County Auditor Pam Goffinet explained to the Council about the cuts and where the levy funds set now after their two-day budget session. She informed them that as of right now, County General fund was cut by \$405,717.00, Health fund was cut by \$30,456.00, the 2015 Reassessment fund was cut by \$175.00 and Cumulative Bridge fund was cut by -0-, total cuts being \$436,348.00. In the four levy funds we were over the maximum levy to begin with. After all that, we are still \$1,932.00 over the max levy which is where we want to be. David Etienne then read the levy amounts and rates for each fund and that the Council needs to adopt for the 2022 rates.
