

EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION
OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE PERRY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2020 the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana approved an Emergency Proclamation regarding the guidelines for reopening of the Perry County Courthouse, Perry County Armory Annex, Perry County Annex South, the Perry County Sheriff and Detention Center, and the Perry County Highway Department on May 18, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, an emergency continues to exist with respect to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Indiana has ordered that all courtrooms remain closed until the 30th day of May, 2020 thus necessitating the continuing closure of the Perry County Courthouse.

IT IS NOW THEREFORE PROCLAIMED by Tom Hauser, in his capacity as President of the Perry County Commissioners, as follows:

1. The COVID-19 Pandemic Emergency continues to exist.
2. In accordance with the Order of the Supreme Court of Indiana, the Perry County Courthouse will remain closed to the public until the Indiana Supreme Court allows Courts to reopen.
3. The remaining portions of the Emergency Proclamation issued by the Board of Commissioners of Perry County, Indiana on May 12, 2020 shall continue in full force and effect.
4. This Emergency Proclamation shall continue for seven (7) days unless continued by the Perry County Commissioners.
