The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES

The minutes from the meeting of April 27, 2017 had been mailed to the Council for their review. There being no changes or revisions, John made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Tom. Motion carried 7-0.

TRANSFERS

Highway Superintendent, Steve Howell, requested a transfer of \$25,000.00 from Stone, \$24,702.00 from Salt, \$25,000.00 from Gas, and \$25,000.00 from Equipment Repair totaling \$99,702.00 to Road Equipment within the Motor Vehicle Highway fund. HIGHWAY – MOTION OF INTENT FOR TRANSFER

Steve Howell, Highway Superintendent, appeared before the Council asking for their intent to approve a transfer in the amount of \$333,333.33 from Bituminous to Local Matching Share line item at their June 22, 2017 meeting. Steve informed them that they are applying for the Community Crossings Grant again this year and this amount is the required 25% match share to receive a \$1,000,000.00. Sheriff Alan Malone informed the Council that he is planning to house inmates from Vanderburgh County Jail and possibly others because of overcrowding. He said they could house 10 with our current population. As of now, we will do this on a trial basis, and if it doesn't work, we will send them back. Sheriff Malone also said that he will need no additional staff. Possibly more janitorial supplies, but we will receive enough revenue in to help out with this. He commented saying that we will receive \$35.00 per day per inmate for housing. John questioned the medical contract, and Alan said that Vanderburgh County will take care of medical for their inmates. Steve and Jody thanked Alan for checking into this and making it work. There being no further business to come before the council, Jody made a motion to adjourn the meeting. John seconded the motion. Motion carried 7-0, with adjournment at 4:45 p.m.
